“ My family members and I are so sorry to learn of Barbara's passing. She was a good friend and neighbor of our parents, Trudet and Pearl Tomlinson, who lived 2 miles east of her on the same road in rural Elmore City. I knew Barbara mostly from her work in Pauls Valley at Jeanne's Sewing Store. Almost 28 years ago, I had a dress made of taffeta to wear as matron of honor for my niece's wedding by a woman who claimed she was an expert seamstress. She took all body measurements, but never called me for a fitting as she had said she would. I picked it up on Friday afternoon about 4:00 PM and had to be in Norman for rehearsal dinner at 7:00 that evening for the 2:00 PM wedding there the next day. The dress did not fit in the bust line....entirely too tight. I took it to Jeanne and Barbara to see if they could put gussets under the sleeves, but Barbara discovered that instead of making the darts for the bust, all of the material had been gathered up and sewn in under the sleeve. Barbara ripped it out without leaving any marks in the material, made the darts properly and when I came back the next morning, it fit perfectly. She saved the day! That was in June. My present husband and I were being married in July and I had left quite expensive material to be made into a wedding dress and material for a dress for my daughter I was gaining with the same woman. Instead, I bought a already made wedding dress and my new 15 year old daughter wore the dress Barbara saved in our family's wedding instead of the one the bad seamstress had made for her. The embroidered chiffon was too pretty to cut into, so my good friend Tammy Delaplain uses it and the crepe lining for it as a table cover in weddings she caters. Barbara was an expert in all sewing or handwork questions as well as a good friend. As well, she was a good person who definitely loved her family.
