Tillman was a man that helped numerous people in his lifetime. He enjoyed helping others pick out show animals, and giving advice on how to raise the best animals possible. He was always available for advice on animals, morals, and life. Tillman was an honorary FFA member in the Elmore City FFA. He was also involved in many other extracurricular

activities and clubs throughout the years as he was raising his children. During his time as a hunting and fishing guide, Tillman got to travel to many places and see many things. All of which were shared in his stories with his family and numerous friends. Tillman lived a very full and exciting life, full of traveling and adventure. Tillman also enjoyed drinking coffee and talking with all the guys at the coffee shop. He enjoyed talking about horses, pigs, hunting, and just about anything. Tillman also enjoyed gardening. He loved to grow many things, but his favorite was tomatoes. He was best known for his heirloom tomatoes, which he was the proudest of. Tillman always planted enough to share with everyone. He loved raising pigs and horses, and loved showing his family how to raise them as well. Tillman was a man who loved others, a man who loved helping others.

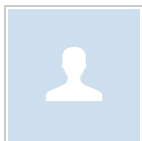
