Alfred B. Ivy of Ft. Worth, Texas, former Duncan resident, was born May 8, 1918 in Foster, Oklahoma to Lonzo and Mamie (Johnson) Ivy and passed from this life on November 16, 2007 in Ft. Worth, Texas at the age of 89 years. Alfred attended school at Foster and Elmore City, Oklahoma. He was awarded the Purple Heart while serving his country in the U.S. Army in the South Pacific during World War II. On February 2, 1946, Alfred married Normada Long in Gainesville, Texas. He worked at Hopeman Equipment as an industrial oil field mechanic for 25 years.
