Alice of Lawton, Ok died on Wednesday September 16th.

Alice was born in Wynnewood Aug. 2, 1930 to Ersel and Annie Barrett Meek. She was the youngest of 4 children. She grew up in Wynnewood and graduated from Wynnewood High School with the class of 1948. She played basketball and was a cheer leader.

Alice also worked for a number of years for Lawton ISD driving a school bus. She retired in 1999.

Alice also loved to play Bridge and played at the Senior Center in Lawton.

She is survived by her 3 children: Patricia Stuart and husband Fred of Norman, Lynn Porter of Marshall, Texas and Fred Lee Porter and wife Vickie

of Denton, Texas.

She is also survived by 6 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

Alice was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church.
