



## Alma Rogers

January 20, 1911 - March 21, 2008

Alma Rogers, the former, Alma Vaughn, was the 8th child of eleven of Samuel and Laura Vaughn of Maysville, Oklahoma. She was the 6th daughter of 8 daughters of her parents. Of the Vaughn's eleven children, they had 8 daughters and 3 sons.

Alma was born on January 20, 1911, in Maysville, Oklahoma and grew up there. Last January, she celebrated her 97th birthday.

Alma attended grade school at a country school "Story" and graduated from high school at Maysville. She attended college at East Central in Ada. She taught school one year and changed professions.

Alma married Claude Rogers of Maysville on March 6, 1949. They had no children. They were both employed at Tinker Air Force Base in Midwest City until retirement and bought a home in Elmore City. They lived there about 40 years. Both were faithful members of the Church of Christ about 80 years. Alma still lived there at time of death.

One of her great-nephews, Ike Wilson, the son of Bileta, the daughter of Bill and Carmoleta Paul, has been with her the last year and 1/2. Bileta's other son Brad Wilson has also been very helpful. The assistance and care provided by a nephew, Jimmy Woodward from Roswell, New Mexico has been

very helpful the last week.

Six sisters and 3 brothers preceded her in death. There is one surviving sister, Carmoleta Paul now living at The Willows at Pauls Valley.

Funeral services for Mrs. Rogers are scheduled for Monday, March 24, 2008 at 2:00 p.m. in the Church of Christ in Elmore City with Joe Terrell officiating.
