



## Bill McManus

February 10, 1929 - May 12, 2014

Billy Gene McManus of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to Jeremiah and May (Fowler) McManus on February 10, 1929 in Whitebead, Oklahoma, the ninth of ten children. He passed from this life on May 12, 2014 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 85 years.

Bill spent his early life in Maysville and Antioch. In 1949, he met and married Shirley Hancock at Whitebead. In 1952 he was inducted into the USMC and was stationed in 29 Palms California.
