On January 26th, 1938 Hilbert and Willie Mae Stevenson became the proud parents of a son, whom they named Bobby Ray Stevenson. He departed this life on February 20, 2010 in Pauls Valley at the age of 72 years. He graduated from Pauls Valley High School in 1957. Bobby served as Sr. Class President and was one of the first black students to graduate from Pauls Valley High School. He excelled in football, basketball, and baseball, and also received a scholarship to play baseball at Langston University.

On June 14th, 1958, he married Minnie Pearl Buckner. To this union three children were born. Bobby was a joy to be around and always went the extra mile for his family, especially his wife Minnie Pearl. He was a dedicated employee and retired from Exxon Mobile after 23 years, and continued working and serving as part owner of Stevenson's BBQ. Bobby enjoyed cooking BBQ, fishing, and socializing. He made sure those around him enjoyed life and he challenged them to be something in life.

Bobby was preceded in death by his father Hilbert Stevenson, one brother, Herman Stevenson Sr., and one grandson Dakota Peters. He leaves to mourn his wife of 52 years, Minnie Pearl Stevenson, and three daughters Charlene Peters married to Stanly Peters, Carla McDaniel, both of Pauls Valley, and Julia Diggs married to Kenny Diggs of Waynesboro, VA and one son Robert Stevenson married to Reulena Stevenson of Oklahoma City. His mother Willie Mae Stevenson of Pauls Valley, one sister Wynona Stevenson of Pauls Valley, and one brother Velmer Stevenson married to Laverne Stevenson of Duncan.

Bobby has eleven grandchildren, seventeen great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild and a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.
