Burl Brown Pyle of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to Elbert and Della (Simmons) Pyle on August 11, 1921 in Elmore City, Oklahoma and passed from this life on May 28, 2010 in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 88 years. Burl grew up and attended school at Brady and Elmore City, graduating in 1939. He then served his country in the U. S. Army Air Corp as a flight engineer of a B29 squadron during World War II.
