Burl Edwin Kennedy of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to C. F. and Ollie (Knight) Kennedy on November 9, 1914 in Katie, Oklahoma and passed from this life on May 1, 2007 in Elmore City, Oklahoma at the age of 92 years.

Burl was born at the old home place in Katie, Oklahoma and grew up and attended school at Satterwhite and Elmore City. On October 29, 1938, he married Daisy Leota Scribner in Atoka, Oklahoma. He served his country in the U. S. Army. Burl was a school teacher at Foster and Elmore City and was also a Superintendent at Elmore City. He also farmed and raised cattle. Burl owned and operated Kennedy Brothers Lumber with his brother Lynn in Elmore City, selling hardware, furniture, and appliances. In 1948 he became a member of the Elmore City First United Methodist Church where he was a Sunday school teacher for the 7th, 8th, and 9th grade boys. In his spare time Burl enjoyed fishing.
