Charles Webber Vann of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to William Hampton and Nancy Mahala (Webber) Vann on November 10, 1928 in Woodville, Oklahoma and passed from this life on April 13, 2018 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 89 years.

Charles grew up in Woodville, Oklahoma. He moved to Kingston, Oklahoma when Lake Texoma was under construction. Charles graduated from Kingston High School and later attended East Central University and Oklahoma Baptist University. He served his country in the U. S. Air Force and the U. S. Army during the post WW II era and Korean conflict. After graduating from East Central University, Charles was the band director at Latta, Oklahoma and Pauls Valley, Oklahoma. Charles later served as an Oklahoma State Representative and Senator. He was a Chickasaw Elder and a member of the Chickasaw Warrior Society. In his spare time, he enjoyed fishing, working in the yard and spending time with friends and family.
