



## Clifton Lee Digby

June 22, 1935 - June 15, 2010

Clifton Lee Digby was born on June 22, 1935, as the fifth of eight children, to L. L. (Blos) and Fannie Wells Digby in Murray County, west of Davis, Oklahoma. He passed peacefully from this world on Tuesday, June 15, 2010 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 74.

After graduating from Davis High School, Clif joined the U.S. Army and became a Chief Operator in the Signal Corps in January 1956. He served in Korea and was honorably discharged in August, 1959.

He married Barbara Joan Barrick in Marietta, Oklahoma on October 25, 1958, with whom he had a son, Robert Luster, and two daughters, Joan Ellen and Cheryl Anne.
