December 15, 1963 - June 13, 2011

Curtis Wayne Stubblefield, formerly of Mansfield, Texas was surrounded by family as he entered Heaven's Gates on June 13, 2011. Curtis had been diagnosed with an aggressive brain tumor (gliosarcoma) in late September 2010 and fought the disease bravely, prior to his passing.

Curtis was born December 15, 1963 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to parents Curtis and Sue Stubblefield. The family moved to Wynnewood, Oklahoma when Curtis was 7 years old and he graduated from Wynnewood High School in 1982.
