



## Don Sharp

February 19, 1933 - May 26, 2011

Donald R. Sharp of Pauls Valley, OK entered this life born to Clarence C. Sharp and Florence H. (Preston) Sharp in Jackson, California on February 19, 1933 and entered eternal life on May 26, 2011 at the age of 78 years.

Don loved model airplanes as a child. He worked alongside his father in the family lumber mill. He was a hard working son and a loving brother to his sisters. He enlisted in the Air Force on July 24, 1950 and was honorably discharged on July 24, 1954. He obtained his private pilot, commercial pilot and instructor rating preparing him for his lifetime career in aviation. Don married the love of his life, Judy Ronda Lents in Chickasha, OK on March 17, 1961.

The couple moved to Pauls Valley in 1963. At that time the Pauls Valley Municipal Airport was an auxiliary air base which saw very little general aviation activity. Don and Judy established their crop dusting business there and set to work. The Sharps established a Cessna dealership and each busy day they kept their personal commitment of improving the life of the Pauls Valley community by making every effort to improve its airport. The vision Don Sharp possessed, combined with hard work and determination, as well as Judy's support, molded the Pauls Valley Airport into what it is today.

Don was a member of the Oklahoma Agriculture Aviation Association and served as president in 1989. He was a life member of the Antique Airplane Association, a member of the Chickasha Auto Club and the Auburn, Cord, Dusenbergs Association. He was a member of the Pauls Valley United

Methodist Church.

Don enjoyed Fly-Ins and Swap Meets. He had a passion for collecting and restoring old cars and airplanes. The highlights of his life were those moments when he was flying and instructing new pilots. Many of his students went on to pursue careers as airline pilots, crop dusters, and military aviation related fields. They all carried with them his love for aviation.

Don loved to work and believed that any goal could be achieved with hard work. He instilled this work ethic in his sons.
