Dorietta Horn McGaughey of Elmore City, Oklahoma entered this life born to Edward Lorance and Hattie Belle (Galloway) Bratcher on December 21, 1918 in Vera, Texas and entered eternal life on Saturday, August 14, 2010 at the age of 91 years.

She spent her childhood days in Texas and New Mexico. Dorietta married Thomas Oyama Horn in Benjamin, Texas on September 23, 1933. Mr. Horn preceded her in death in 1975. She was married to Joe McGaughey eight years later.
