



Dorothy Zachry

January 22, 1936 - September 19, 2010

Dorothy Jo Zachry passed Sunday morning, September 19 2010, following a long illness. Dorothy Jo (who many knew as “Zack”) was born in McGee, Mississippi, in 1936. She graduated from high school in 1955 in Denton, TX. She attended North Texas State College and, in December, 1958, completed her degree at Texas Women’s University in Denton. She then began her teaching career in January, 1959, at Country Estates Elementary School in Midwest City, OK. She spent the majority of her career at Epperly Heights Elementary in Del City. She was awarded a life membership in the PTA in recognition of her contribution to education in the Mid-Del School System. In 1976, Dorothy Jo was the first female elected to the city council in Midwest City. Her election was by citywide vote against a very popular incumbent. She served two terms when the city greatly expanded their fire protection services, introduction of cable television services, improved sanitation services, and as a Trustee of the Hospital, during a period of major expansion.
