Earl Bug Maness, Jr. of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to Earl and Mary Grant (Lavendar) Maness on May 19, 1923 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma and passed from this life on January 23, 2008 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 84 years.
