Eddie Albert Anderson of Pauls Valley was born to Albert L. and Pearl Braden Anderson on August 14, 1925 and entered eternal life on April 17, 2008 at the age of 82 years.

Eddie grew up in Binger, Oklahoma and attended Binger Schools. He and Myrtle Lee Jones were united in marriage on March 4, 1944 in Pauls Valley and enjoyed a life as husband and wife until she preceded him in death. Eddie retired from the Pauls Valley School System and was employed at Otasco for a time. A member of Flipper Chapel AME Church and strong in his faith, Eddie relocated to Bethlehem Baptist Church after the closing of his home church. He was a member of the Pauls Valley React Team and the Elmore City Round Up Club. He enjoyed his CB radio and was known as "Dirty Face".
