Edgar Roy Huffman of Elmore City, OK, born to Henry Quitman "H.Q" and Nora Katherine (Selby) Huffman on January 24, 1917 in Foster, Oklahoma, passed from this life on November 17, 2006 at the age 89 years.

Edgar married Naomi Elizabeth "Dixie" Roller on September 30, 1939 in Pauls Valley. Edgar and Dixie have lived in Antioch area for 46 years.

Edgar and Dixie began their lives together farming. Edgar began his career with Globe Oil Company in the mid 1940's; which later became Phillips Petroleum Oil Company. He retired November 1, 1979 as a pumper . Edgar spent the remainder of his retirement tending to his ranch and cattle, often on horseback, fishing and spending time with his family.

Edgar is well known in the local coffee shop for his morning discussions of current events and more importantly community chitchat. The world is a better place having known the amount of world problems solved at the local Badger Den and Gas'N Go.

Edgar was preceded in death by his parents: Henry and Katherine, four brothers, Bernest, Ernest, Lee, Hansel and Glen, and two sisters Ruby and Edna.
