



## Fay LeRoy Watters

March 24, 1924 - July 2, 2010

FAY LeROY WATTERS RETURNED TO HIS HEAVENLY FATHER ON JULY 2, 2010.

HE WAS THE FIRST OF 13 CHILDREN BORN TO LEROY AND ISABEL WATTERS ON MARCH 24, 1924 IN BEAVER, UTAH. HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS. FAY SERVED A MISSION IN FRESNO, CALIFORNIA AND SERVED IN THE STOREHOUSE, TEMPLES AND IN MANY OTHER CHURCH CALLINGS. HE MARRIED DEAN (PHELPS) WATTERS ON JANUARY 30, 1947 IN FILLMORE, UTAH AND TOGETHER THEY HAD 9 CHILDREN.

HE LIVED THE MAJORITY OF HIS LIFE IN UTAH WORKING AS A WELDER FOR GENEVA STEEL IN OREM, UTAH FOR 38 YEARS. HE HAS LIVED IN PAULS VALLEY, OKLAHOMA FOR THE PAST 3 YEARS.

MR. WATTERS WAS A VETERAN OF THE U.S.NAVY HAVING SERVED HIS COUNTRY IN WWII IN THE ASIATIC PACIFIC THEATRE AND PHILLIPINE LIBERATION.

HE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HIS PARENTS, 2 CHILDREN, RICHARD LeROY WATTERS AND FAYE LaDEAN WATTERS LEEDS, HIS SIBLINGS, KEITH WATTERS, HOWARD WATTERS, ELAINE VAN ZINE, DELOY WATTERS, AND DELLA VEE WATTERS.
