Glenn Stratton Agnew burst onto the scene April 18, 1944 to proud parents Julius D. & Iva Lemley Agnew in Tyler, Texas. The family moved to Pauls Valley in 1960 where Glenn entered his sophomore year at Pauls Valley High School. Well-liked and well-respected, Glenn was involved in all sports and excelled in academics.

Glenn furthered his education at the University of East Central where he received his B.A. degree in 1967. He continued to expand his expertise by obtaining his Securities License (Series 7, 22, 63 & 65) .

Before expanding into the Securities business, Glenn was owner & operator for Agnew and Smartt Clothing in Ardmore, Oklahoma (the largest men and women's clothing store between Oklahoma City & Dallas at that time). Taking advantage of business opportunities, Glenn then made his way up the ladder of success beginning with Valmont Oil Field Products, Little Deutag Drilling Company, finally becoming Vice-

President of Merrico Oil & Gas Investment Company. These experiences created the basis for Glenn's interest in real estate investment trusts where he excelled as Vice-President of The Myers Group, Southmark/Envicon of New York, Inland Investments of Oak Brook, Illinois, Triple Net Properties of Santa Ana, California, Cole Companies of Phoenix, Arizona, and Ntreit Real Estate Companies of Escondido, California, and Arciterra of Phoenix, Az.

Although working from ocean to ocean within the boundaries of the United States, his home was Pauls Valley where he married the love of his life, Pamala Bridges Patterson, on February 18, 1984. Along with raising their family, Glenn was an integral part of the First United Methodist church where he held numerous offices on various boards. Glenn was also active within the community as a member of the Kiwanis club, on the Park and Recreation Board for several years, and a 32nd degree Mason.

Glenn's passions included history, reading, OU football, music, cars, BUT for all who knew Glenn, it was easy to see the greatest joy and happiness was as a husband and father. He and Pam dated in High School but reunited later at a High School Reunion. They have been nicknamed as a "love team"! He adored their children, Brian Patterson of Pauls Valley, Nicole Lackey and her husband Curtiss of Luther, Sara Smith of Ardmore, and Richard D. Agnew and his wife Brandy of Austin, Texas. The twinkle in Glenn's eye revolved around his

grandchildren Chase, Conner, & Teryn Patterson of Pauls Valley, Tristan Patterson, Douglas-Ann Smith of Ardmore, Stratton, Jacob & Scarlett Lackey of Luther, and Cruz, Stella, & Van Agnew of Austin, Texas. Glenn's close family members include a sister, Wilma Agnew Jones and her husband Wilton of Kilgore, Texas; his brother Dale Agnew and wife Robin of Carrollton, Texas; brother Jay Agnew and his wife Paula of Plano, Texas and sister Ann and her husband Charles Morgan of Edington, North Carolina as well as numerous nieces, nephews & cousins.

On August 6, 2012, Glenn triumphantly joined God's heavenly kingdom. A service to celebrate Glenn's memorable life will be held Friday, August 10, 2012, @ 11 o'clock am at the First United Methodist Church of Pauls Valley officiated by Rev. Mark Watson under the direction of Wooster Funeral Home.

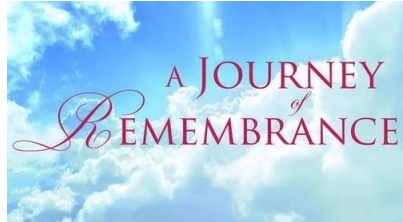

Pam never said a word just looked at Glenn with these big disappointed eyes and quickly closed the door and left. Glenn put out the cigarette and tucked his tail really close and left. I guess he survived but he never once smoked ever, ever, ever again. I am sure Pam bonded with him to the extreme. Glenn and I laughed about that for many years to come.

Pam rest assured Glenn thought of nothing more than how to satisfy and take care of you. His love for you could never be expressed to the guys but you just knew how much he cared for you. His every passing moment was always I got to get home to Pam, What about Pam, What will Pam think? We have all heard this from Glenn. By definition look up what true love is and you have been so fortunate to know that your Glenn truly loved you.

I am so glad I took time to come to your house just before we moved out of town because I wanted to see my friend one last time before leaving. I will cherish that memory in my heart.

Glenn is not suffering anymore as he and Keith are having a great time. The only comfort at this time is to know you have friends and family who will help you walk down this lonely path. You are not alone. You carry Glenn in your heart so lift him up in times of sorrow and laugh with him in the times of joy. Pam thank you for sharing him with us.

Judy and I regret that we will not be able to come this Friday and we will continue to hold you and your family up in prayer. We look forward to seeing you the next time we are in the Valley.
