Glenn Theodore Ford Sr. "Jody" was born in Pauls Valley, May 2, 1943 to William Wesley Fields and Frankie Ford. He was the oldest of ten children. He attended Dunbar Elementary School. He went into the Navy January 31, 1967, where he received numerous medals: National Defense; Vietnam Service; Fleet Marine; Force Combat Insignia; Vietnam Campaign; and First Good Conduct Award. He then began to serve his country in the Army in 1968 and became part of the 173rd Airborne Brigade Association. His most outstanding accomplishment was receiving the Purple Heart.
