Gloria Walling of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to George and Bamma (Evans) Sheafor on May 2, 1926 in a tent in Wirt (Ragtown), Oklahoma and passed from this life on April 14, 2009 in Tecumseh, Oklahoma at the age of 82 years.

Gloria began her schooling at Dundee and Cox City schools before moving to Brownstown, Illinois where she graduated. While her brothers were serving during war time, Gloria worked as a Rosie the Riveter in Illinois. On August 2, 1947, Gloria married Kenneth Walling in Altamont, Illinois. They made their home in Seminole, Oklahoma until returning to Illinois in 1953. They later moved to Elmore City, Oklahoma where Gloria worked for the First State Bank of Elmore City in 1960. She began as a bookkeeper and advanced to Vice President and cashier. Gloria loved her job at the bank and working with the Gibson family. In 1998, Gloria retired but remained on the Board of Directors until August of 2002 when she moved to Dale, Oklahoma to be with her daughter, Vicki. In her spare time, Gloria enjoyed collecting antique red satin lamps and other antiques. She also loved old cars and working in the yard. She was a member of the Elmore City First United Methodist Church.
