Altus Hugh Robinson of Elmore City, Oklahoma October 14, 1923, passed peacefully from this life Pauls Valley General Hospital on June 8, 2009 at the age of 85 years. He was the 8th of 9 children born to Washington Perk Robinson and Cora Mae Tomlinson Robinson in Elmore City. On August 7, 1948, he and Margaret Smith were united in marriage and to this union were born two children, Dolores and David.

Hugh made the oil field his lifelong career. He worked for many drilling companies over the years including Kerr-McGee, Beacon Drilling Co., Beard Drilling, Falcon Seaboard, Jernigan Drilling and Culver Drilling. During his early drilling days, he, Margaret and the kids moved around several times with the various companies when work called for it. He is also a WWII veteran having served in the U. S. Army from 1944 to 1946.
