Jack Henderson Cook of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to Walter Luther and Bessie Acenith (Simmons) Cook on April 22, 1927 in Foster, Oklahoma and passed from this life on Sunday, January 19, 2014 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 86 years.

Jack grew up and attended school at Burrs High and Dibble High where he excelled in basketball. After graduation, Jack served his country in the U. S. 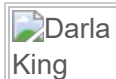
