



James Roy "Jim" Fullerton

Pauls Valley resident James (Jim) Roy Fullerton passed away Tuesday, February 21, 2012 in Plano, TX at the age of 83. He was born August 16, 1928 in Altus, OK to Joseph Hayes and Julia Fullerton.

Jim married Ellen Fullerton on August 24, 2001 in Pauls Valley, OK.

Mr. Fullerton graduated high school and attended Wichita State University following general studies. Jim served in the U.S. Army and worked two years for the U.S. Air Force. He also worked for various aircraft manufacturers before going to work for the U.S. Navy in 1966 as a civil service employee.
