



## J.C. "Choc" Murray

J. C. "Choc" Murray was called from this life on Saturday, July 19 2008, at the age of 95. He was born in Wanette, Oklahoma to Louis A. Murray and Willie Mae (Conner) Murray on December 18, 1912. He was a faithful member of the Paul and Pine Church of Christ, baptized at a very young age.

He graduated from Whitebead School and met Anna Belle Hall. They were married in Gainsville, Texas on October 11, 1941.
