August 8, 1932 - January 12, 2015

Jo Ann Poteet of Lindsay, Oklahoma was born to Robert Ardell and Olga (Harrell) Lester on August 28, 1932 and passed from this life on January 12, 2015 in Duncan, Oklahoma at the age of 82 years.

Jo Ann grew up and attended school in Duncan and graduated high school in 1949. In 1951, Jo Ann married her high school sweetheart and the love of her life, Robert D. "Bob" Poteet in Lusk, Wyoming. Bob and Jo Ann opened B & B Tool in Ratliff City in 1960. Six months later, they relocated to Lindsay, Oklahoma. They established B. & B. Tool Co. Inc. followed with yards in Whitesboro, Texas and Ada, Oklahoma. Jo Ann kept bookkeeping records for the family business most of her life. Jo Ann enjoyed going out to the movies and dinners, and also followed Robert to years of horse racing events. Jo Ann was a founding member of the Lucky Circle Social Club in Duncan, Oklahoma that was established in the late 1940's and sponsored by the famous Jean Speegle Howard. The Lucky Circle Social Club is still in existence today.
