Jo Ree Bird Bromley, age 94—formerly of Elmore City and Pauls Valley, Oklahoma—passed to her heavenly home May 23, 2021.

Jo Ree was born in Marshall, Texas to Elva Gracie Elledge and Joseph William Bird. She married Lawrence Edward (Bill) Bromley on June 5, 1948; the same month, they moved to Antioch, Oklahoma, where Bill worked for Warren Petroleum (Gulf). After the birth of their son Bill Raydon, they moved to Elmore City, Oklahoma. Throughout Bill's school years, Jo Ree volunteered as a homeroom mother, worked in the concession stands at school events, and never missed an athletic event in which young Bill participated.

She was preceded in death by Bill, her husband of 49 years.
