JoAnn Courtney of Elmore City, Oklahoma was one of 10 children born to Magnalena and Jessie Horn. She was born November 19, 1933, in Orr, Oklahoma. She took her last breath on April 16, 2023 with family at her side at the age of 89. JoAnn's husband and nine other siblings (5 brothers and 4 sisters) proceeded her in death.

In earlier days, JoAnn attended school in Wynnewood, Oklahoma. On August 9, 1952, she married the late Kenneth Courtney in Ardmore, Oklahoma and they made their home in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma for many years. JoAnn's legacy was one of kindness, modesty, honor, generosity and genuine integrity. She was as good a cook as a seamstress and enjoyed sharing meals with others.

Mrs. Courtney is survived by three daughters; Connie Fogle (husband Martin) of Oklahoma City, Sandra Bumgarner (husband Larry) of Lake Texoma, and Elizabeth Courtney of Elmore City. She is blessed to have one Grandson, Jeromé Fogle (wife Jami) of Mulhall, Oklahoma and granddaughter, Courtney Carpenter (husband Caleb) of Piedmont, Oklahoma. 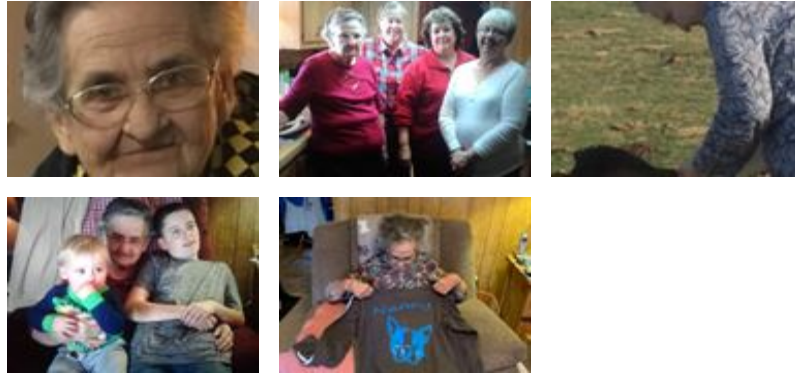
