



Joe Anne Blevins

November 27, 1934 - February 7, 2017

Joe Anne Blevins was born to Bud and Melba Irene (Hines) Crow on November 27, 1934 in Rock Hill, Texas and passed from this life on February 7, 2017 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 82 years.

Joe Anne grew up, attended and graduated school in Abilene, Texas. She also attended Hardin Simmons University in Abilene.

On January 11, 1958, Joe Anne married Hal Blevins in Albany, Texas. They eventually made their home in Pauls Valley.

Joe Anne's first love was for her family, the Pauls Valley General Hospital and the welfare of the people.

She established the first Medical Records Department at the N.H. Lindsey Memorial Hospital and then at the Pauls Valley General Hospital in 1970. She served the hospital faithfully for 31 years. During this tenure, she also served as secretary for the medical staff.

After retiring from the hospital, she re-established the Medical Records Department at the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center. She retired from SORC after 10 years of service. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Pauls Valley.

Joe Anne loved ranching and raising cattle with Hal. In her spare time, she enjoyed playing canasta, poker, bingo and was known to be present at the casino when the mood struck her.

Mrs. Blevins is survived by her husband, Hal of the home; three sons – Gary and wife Terri of Conroe, Texas, and Larry and Jeff Blevins of Elmore City,

Oklahoma; two daughters – Janet Guinn and husband Tim of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and Cindy Browne and husband J.D. of Huntsville, Texas; six grandchildren; and 10 great-grandchildren.

Joe Anne was preceded in death by her parents; her sister, Patsy Jane Sellers; her son, John Holland; and one grandchild, Cody John Maddox.

Memorial services will be held at the First Presbyterian Church in Pauls Valley on Tuesday, February 14, 2017 at 2 p.m.
