Juanita B. Garner, formerly of Elmore City, was born on July 07, 1907 in Chagers, Oklahoma in Carter County to John Henry and Ada Vina (Keenan) Welch and entered eternal life on Sunday, May 18, 2008 in Jourdanton, Texas at the age of 100 years. Juanita grew up in the Satterwhite and Eola area and moved to Elmore City in 1946 where she resided until 2 years ago. On October 16, 1926, Juanita married Leonard Thurman Garner in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma. She was a member of the First Baptist Church of Elmore City. Juanita loved the outdoors, particularly flowers and gardening. She was known for her wonderful cooking. Her family and friends were the highlights of her life.
