Katherine Fee of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to Henry Hubert and Matilda Mary (Thiel) Franken on April 24, 1923 in Norborne, Missouri and passed from this life on March 7, 2009 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 85 years.

Mrs. Fee grew up on a farm one of 11 children. Her father passed away early in her life. Katherine graduated from St. Joseph Hospital School of Nursing in September of 1944.
