Lacey loved having her hair and makeup done and loved how pretty it made her feel, even though everyone knew how beautiful of a person she was with or without it on. Her children loved her cooking. They loved her meatloaf, enchiladas, and she loved having BBQ's with family and friends. Friends were very important to her as they became her non-biological family, they would do everything together, from bonfires, to birthday parties, to concerts, to creating bucket lists together even noting that some of the things on that bucket list the others had no idea about. Lacey was almost finished with her Associates in Early Childhood Development for the Head Start Program, and she was so proud of herself for that. Her love for kids also showed in the way she substituted for the Elmore City Public Schools in the Elementary, Junior High, and High School. Lacey spent most of her career as a Receptionist in the Medical field, but before that she worked as a Home

Health Nurse for the Pauls Valley Hospital before it shut down. 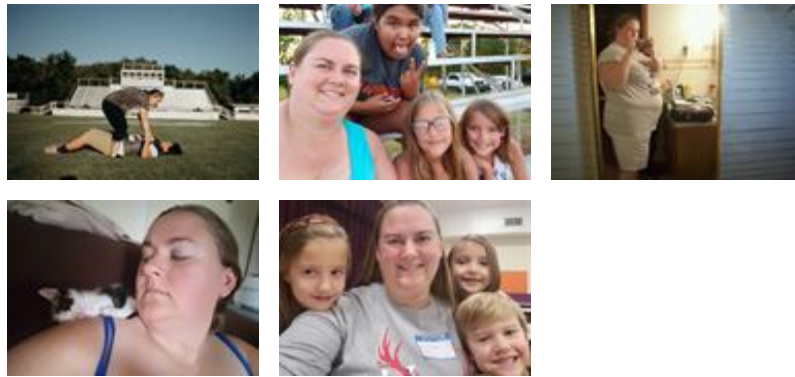
