Mrs. Lavinia McAdams of Pauls Valley, OK was born on May 31, 1921 to Obid and Willie Mae (West) Laurence and entered eternal life on Wed., August 1, 2007. She was one of seven children. Lavinia graduated from Pauls Valley High School in 1939 and then attended business school. Next, Lavinia worked in our community at the Pure Oil Company, Wackers Offices and Supply and Lintz Dept. Store as typist and bookkeeper.

After World War II, Lavinia married (the late building contractor and public servant) James H. McAdams (1946). In 1952 their son, James Laurence (Jimmy), was born at Lindsey Memorial Hospital in PV. Lavinia then stayed home to be wife and mother. Later, Lavinia returned to work with her business skills at Pauls Valley Hospital and then Garvin County Services. Her son Jimmy was married to Mary in 1980 and in 1990 her only grandchild, Ian, was born. Ian became her newest career.

Lavinia has been a member of Beaty Baptist Church, Trinity Baptist and the First Baptist Church of PV. While husband Jim taught a men's Sunday School class for years, Lavinia was a leader of the 5/6 years old Sunday School class. She volunteered every summer for 15 years to teach in the Vacation Bible School at First Baptist Church. Lavinia enjoyed church hymns, bible study, flower gardening, fashion, whipping up a great batch of fudge and spending time with her beloved family.
