Lecil Ovene Brady of Marlow, Oklahoma was born to Eura Thomas and Malinda (James) Brady on July 25, 1925 in Wynnewood, Oklahoma passed from this life on June 29, 2007 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 81 years.

Lecil grew up and attended school in Oklahoma and New Mexico. He served his country in the U. S. Navy during World War II. Lecil married Edna Meadows on April 25, 1946 in Elk City, Oklahoma.
