Leo Winfred Mullens was born in Elmore City, Oklahoma on April 25, 1928 to Roy and Juanita Mullens. He exited this world on November 29, 2006 in Lawton, Oklahoma at the age of 78 years.

Leo attended school in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma and graduated high school in 1946. While in high school Leo's love for music lead him to sing with a gospel quartet, which consisted of Leo, Leroy Weatherford, Cleeta and Junell Gooch. The quartet sang on the radio and other gospel gatherings.
