Lester Lee Moore of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to Lester Moore and Ethel Viola (Jones) on February 20, 1938 in Oak Hill, Oklahoma and passed from this life on December 23, 2023 in Norman Oklahoma at the age of 85 years. Lester was saved and baptized as a child at the age of eight. He has always carried the word of God in his heart and believed in Christ as his Lord and Savior.

Lester grew up in the Golden, Idabel, and Broken Bow, Oklahoma areas. He was smart as could be as a child and was promoted from the 4th grade to the 6th grade in school. He worked hard for and with his family plowing fields and picking cotton. He moved to Louisiana as an early adult and lived in Rodessa, Louisiana where he became a Veteran of the US Army Reserves. Lester was later called back during the Korean Crisis to serve as a Heavy Equipment Operator and Ammunitions Specialist overseas in Germany. He received an Honorable Discharge from the Army in May of 1964.

In 1963, Lester married Emma Jean Goodson and they had a son Michael Shane Moore in 1964. They later divorced and in 1967 he married Wanda May Spears and had three daughters: Linda, Rebecca, and Melissa. Lester and his family lived in the area of Velma, Pernell, and Emore City. He was a man of many skills. He was self-employed most of his life starting in the logging business in Texarkana. He also worked in the oil field industry for

many years as a heavy equipment operator. Lester was self-employed for close to 40 years as a dozer, backhoe, and dump truck operator, and diesel mechanic. His other skills included working as a car salesman in his younger years in Cordell, Oklahoma and welding in a shipyard in Beaumont, TX as an older adult. He was also an amazing carpenter, plumber, and mason and could build or repair almost anything.

Retiring in 2008, Lester loved to spend time fishing, enjoying nature, and sharing his mechanic skills with others. In his spare time, as a young man he enjoyed playing pool and in his later years he loved watching western movies and professional football on TV.
