Linda Harris was born August 29, 1945 to George Alfred and Joan Helen (Glaser) Davis in Elmore City, Oklahoma. She died Sunday, October 11 in Oklahoma City after a brief illness.

Raised in Maysville, Oklahoma, Linda was a 1963 graduate of Maysville High School where she was a cheerleader. She later attended East Central University in Ada.

Linda married the love of her life, Ronald Harris, on March 1, 1963 in Purcell. They made their home in Pauls Valley where they raised both of their children and have been active in their community since moving here. She was a lifelong member of St. Catherine of Sienna Catholic Church. She was first and foremost a homemaker who loved taking care of her family.

Linda was preceded in death by her parents and one sister, Jan Owen. She is survived by her husband, Ron, of the home; a daughter, Rhonda Harris
