



## Lorean Idella Hammons

June 24, 1920 - February 9, 2007

Lorean Idella Hammons was born in the Roady Community on June 24, 1920 to Ben Erskin and Addie Marjorie (Scarberry) Cobb. She passed from this life February 9, 2007 at the age of 86 years, 7 months and 16 days.

She married Yual Hammons in Oklahoma City on October 24, 1946. Mr. Hammons preceded her in death on April 15, 1991. They were blessed with one son and one daughter. Lorean was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother who loved her family very much. She enjoyed gardening, cooking for others, canning, raising flowers and especially loved visiting with her family and friends.

She was baptized in to the Church of Christ on November 19, 1939. She attended services regularly until her health prevented her from doing so. She was a resident of the Oklahoma Veterans Center at Sulphur, Oklahoma since 2002. Lorean enlisted in the WAC's in March, 1943 and was honorably discharged in February, 1946 with a rank of Sgt., where she worked as a clerical orderly during WWII. Except for the time she was in service and a resident at the Veterans Center, Lorean had lived her entire life in the Garvin County area.

She is survived by one daughter, Linda Johnson and Randy of Elmore City, Oklahoma and one son, Donald Hammons of Dallas, Texas; 4 grandchildren:
