



## Louise Deaton

June 25, 1923 - September 4, 2008

Louise Deaton of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to Albert Harley and Sarena Floye (Broughton) West on June 25, 1923 in Francis, Oklahoma and passed from this life on September 4, 2008 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 85 years.

Louise grew up and attended school in Francis, Oklahoma. In 1941, Louise married Joseph Deaton in Ada, Oklahoma and they made their home there until moving to Pauls Valley in 1949. Louise worked as a dental hygienist for Dr. Royal P. Lewis , Dr. G. D. Smith, Sr. and Dr. Glen D. Smith, Jr., and also for Dr. Don Meinders. She became curator for the Santa Fe Depot for ten years and was greatly involved in the whole restoration of the depot. Louise used her gardening skills with the landscaping for the depot. She also served as a Cub Scout, Girl Scout and Brownie leader. Mrs. Deaton was active in gardening clubs, Extension Homemakers, and worked in the Rotary rose garden. Louise received accommodation from Governor Frank Keating, was honored by the 4-H Club and was Pauls Valley Citizen of the Year.
