

## Loyd Estes Taylor

August 8, 1922 - February 8, 2011

Loyd Estes Taylor was born on August 8, 1922 in Smithville, TN., son of William and Cleo Taylor. Loyd married Nellie Mae Simmons on May 26, 1947 in Chickasha, OK. Together they had 21 children, 54 grandchildren, 72 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great-grandchildren. Loyd went to be with his Lord on February 8, 2011 at the age of eighty-eight.

Loyd was a lifetime resident of Lindsay and surrounding area. He served in the U.S. Navy in the Seabees during WWII. Following the war he farmed for many years. He also worked at Lindsay Builders Supply, Western Auto and for Lindsay Public Schools as a bus mechanic and bus driver until his retirement in 2000.

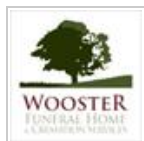
