Marion Francis Turner was born on August 22, 1911 in St. Louis, Missouri to George Ernest and Marion Ethel (Arrowsmith) Turner and passed from this life on Wednesday, November 19, 2008 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 97 years. Francis spent his childhood doing farm work and walked a great distance to school and back, regardless of the weather. He farmed, hunted (especially coon hunting), fished, and saved money for his first car, a Model A, which cost \$50.00. On April 20, 1935 in Ewing, Missouri, Francis married Jewel Katherine Olinger. He was a foster grandparent for six years, and in 2001 he had 677 hours of service. In 2001 he received a commendation from the State of Oklahoma as a distinguished and outstanding volunteer. Francis felt that caring for children was the most rewarding thing in life. He enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. In later years, he was an avid bird watcher. Marion loved his church and serving the Lord. He was a member of the Valley Christian Church.
