Mary Patterson Jordan of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to John and Stella (Walker) Patterson on March 14, 1921 in Macreeville, Texas and passed from this life on October 18, 2009 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma at the age of 88 years. Mary grew up in San Saba, Texas and graduated from San Saba High School in 1938. She married Joseph Durwood Jordan on May 13, 1938. Mary and Joe moved 38 times during their marriage, settling in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma in June 1957 where they lived for the next 52 years.
