Mueton Bostic of Wynnewood, Oklahoma was born on October 7, 1922 to Jim Cheatham and Fannie (Ward) Bostic in Foster, Oklahoma and passed from this life on September 20, 2007 at the age of 84 years.

Mueton grew up and attended school in Foster, Elmore City and Stratford, Oklahoma. Wynnewood has been his home for the past 59 years. Mueton married Wanda Mignon Prather on February 8, 1943 in Purcell, Oklahoma. 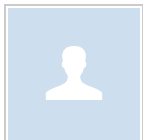
