Nannette Bruce Ridge Thomas was born to Thomas W. Bruce and Dena (Best) Bruce on September 13, 1929 in Oklahoma City, OK. She went to her heavenly home on June 12, 2018, at the age of 88.

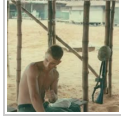
