Odessa Verna Corban Rozell was born October 7, 1914 to William Theodore Corban and Elmina Murr Corban in Stratford, Oklahoma. Odessa married Waymon "Rosy" Rozell on May 18, 1933. They moved to Ft. Worth where Odessa worked for Douglas Air Craft. After the war they moved back to Oklahoma. Odessa was the building manager of the American Fidelity Building in Pauls Valley where she retired at 85 years of age. Odessa was a Sunday School teacher at the First Baptist Church for several years. She was Grand Marshall of the Rebecca.
