Paula represented the state of Louisiana in various gold gloves boxing tournaments. Paula rode in the Mardi Gras parade in Lafayette and appeared on television to promote the state boxing tournament. She present trophies to the 25 winners in their various divisions. She was voted most beautiful and most popular at Comeaux High School, where she later graduated in 1973 in Lafayette, Louisiana. She then attended East Central University with a bachelor's degree in accounting.

While at East Central, Paula was a member of the Sorority, Pi Kapa Alpha. Paula worked for Joe and Janet Moore at Moore Sonic Management Group since 2004. In her spare time, she enjoyed playing dominoes, reading, crafts, needle point, and games with her grandchildren. Paula loved to joke around and spend time with family and friends. Paula was a daily rider on the Delta Public Transit bus in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma where she met and bonded with many people over time. 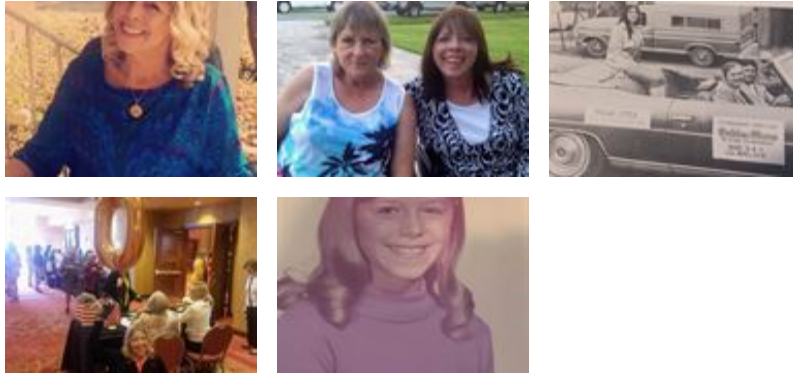
