Jimmie Pauline (Shaw) Evans of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to James David and Julia Ann (Howard) Shaw in Antioch, OK on May 28, 1917. Pauline was 94 years young when she went to be with her Lord on December 31, 2011.

Pauline lived in Garvin County the majority of her years. She married Charles “Jack” Evans in Chickasha, OK on August 12, 1936 and they were faithful to their marriage covenant until death parted them when Jack passed away on December 4, 1997. The couple lived in California for awhile and worked for Douglas Aircraft. Early on when they were raising their family they farmed in the Beaty and Whitebead areas.
