Pearl Edith Dewberry was born November 24, 1914 south of Eola, Oklahoma to Charles Edwin "Ed" and Bessie Evelie Pyle. Her twin, Earl preceded her in death in 1996. She was also preceded in death by her other siblings: Inez Johnson, Mabel Stubblefield, Jim Pyle, and Venita Kennedy Langdon.

She married Alton B. Dewberry on October 8, 1936. He preceded her in death on January 25, 2003. This marriage was blessed with one child, Larry Keith. Keith was killed in a car accident east of Elmore City on Mother's Day, 1955. Pearl went to school at Satterwhite and Elmore City and worked in the fields all of her young life helping to scratch out a living for her family. Alton and Pearl operated a grocery store in Elmore City. She worked in several stores in Elmore City and helped to care for her grandmother, mother, and dad in their home until their deaths.
