She accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of Pilgrim Baptist Church in Tatums, OK all of her life. Rosie attended school in Tatums, OK. She worked as a cook at the Headstart in Tatums, OK, before retiring. She was a very faithful servant of the Lord up until the Lord called her home. She served as Sunday school secretary and church treasurer for numerous years, and one of the eldest mothers of the church. Even after her health started to fail; she still read and studied her word to show herself approved. Even when she could barely utter a word or move her limbs; she was able to call upon her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and managed to waive a rejoiceful hand to the Lord.

Rosie met and married Earl C. Watts in 1951. She had 9 children. She enjoyed being a homemaker and really loved taking care of her children, cooking, quilting, singing, and doing hair.
